Q. Can you tell me about Limited Races and if those earnings count for SCBRA points?

A. Limited entry races that require you to be a member to run or ride a certain type of horse, cannot be SCBRA approved so any earnings/points WILL NOT count.

- * Open races that allow Slot races or limited races to roll into the Open cannot be counted towards points with SCBRA.

- * Points will not count from any barrel race that allows rolled times from a race that is limited. Neither the limited race nor the rolled time may count for SCBRA.

- * Limited races include but are not limited to races where you must be a member to run. Examples would be Slot races, BBR, WPRA, NBHA, MHBH, Paint Horse Assoc., etc.

All of the races that have the **SCBRA APPROVED** logo on the flyer are races that we will accept for SCBRA points. Approved races will also be listed in our newsletter each month. A list of our producer/approved races for our **2017 season are found under "Who Are We?" in this newsletter.**

An example would be the upcoming MHBH race that is limited to members **only on Mother's Day. Any money won at that race will not count for SCBRA points since it is "limited" to members only.**

Adams County Fairgrounds-Brighton

The Adams County Regional Park Complex is located at 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton, Colorado which is one mile west of U.S. 85 on 124th Avenue. (124th Avenue turns into Henderson Road when it crosses the South Platte River.)
From Denver - take I-25 N to I-76. Take I-76 to U.S. Highway 85 N to 124th Avenue. Turn west on 124th Avenue and go one mile to the entrance of the Regional Park Complex.

Arapahoe County Fairgrounds-Aurora

25690 East Quincy Avenue, Aurora, CO 80016, From the North-Follow I-25 S, I-270 E and I-70 E to US-40 W/E Colfax Ave in Adams County. Take exit 288 from I-70 E. Take S Picadilly Rd, E 6th Ave, CO-30 E/S Gun Club Rd and Airline Rd/E Quincy Ave to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County. From the South-Follow I-25 N to Castle Rock. Take exit 184 from I-25 N, Take N Crowfoot Valley Rd, CO-83 N/S Parker Rd and S Aurora Pkwy to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County.

Boulder County Fairgrounds-Longmont

From I-25: Take I-25 to the Longmont or Highway 119 exit West into Longmont. Highway 119 turns into Ken Pratt Blvd. Take Ken Pratt past the railroad tracks. Turn right on Nelson Road right after the tracks. Go almost two blocks directly to the Fairgrounds, which will be on your right.

Hadley's Arena-Canon City

West on Academy to Hwy 115 turn left on 115 (South) and take it thru the canyon to Hwy 50. Take Hwy 50 all the way into the heart of Canon City to 9th Street. (Loaf and Jug on one corner, other three corners are banks).
