# Bulletin Board

Q. I heard that the rules for “rolled times” has changed from last year. Can you please explain the new rule?

A. LIMITED BARREL RACES may NOT count for SCBRA points. OPEN barrel races that allow times to be rolled from a limited race will NOT count for SCBRA.

LIMITED BARREL RACES include but are not limited to Slot Races &/or races where you must be a member to run (such as races where you must be a member of BBR, WPRA, NBHA, MHBH or Paint Horse Assoc., etc.).

Money earned in Youth, 50+ or Novice Horse classes must stay in the division it was earned. OPEN money may be counted in any division since other classes are not always offered at every race. The money won can only be counted once and only one money per division.

For example: You run your horse in the Open and then roll your time to 50+. You win \$150 in the Open and your rolled time wins you \$60 in the 50+. For SCBRA you can do the following:

Apply the \$150 to your Open points; and apply the \$60 to the 50+ points; OR apply the \$150 to your 50+ points and none in the Open. It would be the same if it is the Youth or Novice Horse division. You CANNOT roll your money from the “limited division” back to the Open Division.

# Directions

## Adams County Fairgrounds-Brighton

The Adams County Regional Park Complex is located at 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton, Colorado which is one mile west of U.S. 85 on 124th Avenue. (124th Avenue turns into Henderson Road when it crosses the South Platte River.)  
From Denver - take I-25 N to I-76. Take I-76 to U.S. Highway 85 N to 124th Avenue. Turn west on 124th Avenue and go one mile to the entrance of the Regional Park Complex.

## Arapahoe County Fairgrounds-Aurora

25690 East Quincy Avenue, Aurora, CO 80016, From the North-Follow I-25 S, I-270 E and I-70 E to US-40 W/E Colfax Ave in Adams County. Take exit 288 from I-70 E. Take S Picadilly Rd, E 6th Ave, CO-30 E/S Gun Club Rd and Airline Rd/E Quincy Ave to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County. From the South-Follow I-25 N to Castle Rock. Take exit 184 from I-25 N, Take N Crowfoot Valley Rd, CO-83 N/S Parker Rd and S Aurora Pkwy to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County.

## Boulder County Fairgrounds-Longmont

From I-25: Take I-25 to the Longmont or Highway 119 exit West into Longmont. Highway 119 turns into Ken Pratt Blvd. Take Ken Pratt past the railroad tracks. Turn right on Nelson Road right after the tracks. Go almost two blocks directly to the Fairgrounds, which will be on your right.

## Crossroads Arena-Penrose

Take I-25 to HWY 50 West out of Pueblo to Penrose. Take exit for CO-115 towards Florence. 13760 Colorado 115, Penrose, CO 81240

## Douglas County Fairgrounds-Castle Rock

From the South: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of N I-25, turn right (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd. From the North: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of S I-25, turn left (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd..

## El Paso County Fairgrounds- Calhan

Hwy 24 east to Calhan Hwy. Turn south (left) and the fairgrounds are on the right.

## Hadley's Arena-Canon City

I-25 South through Colorado Springs to Academy Blvd (the second Academy Blvd) it's SOUTH of the city (pass the World Arena, etc). West on Academy to Hwy 115 turn left on 115 (South) and take it thru the canyon to Hwy 50.  
Take Hwy 50 all the way into the heart of Canon City to 9th Street. (Loaf and Jug on one corner, other three corners are banks). At 9th Street take a left (south) go up the hill thru the round about and keep heading south....cemetery on left fairgrounds on right.....rd naturally curves to the left .... Take that and you'll be going East. Look up and you'll see Cathi's barn. Keep going East to Stop Sign at Pine...turn right onto Pine at Stop Sign and enter the facility at the first set of gates on left.

## McKnight's Arena-Pueblo

Take S I-25 to exit 98A toward Hwy50/La Junta, turn left onto Hwy 50/Santa Fe Ave, turn right onto 28th Lane, arena is on the left.

## Norris Penrose Event Center- Colorado Springs

From the South: Take exit 141 Cimarron St. off of N I-25, turn left (west) onto Cimarron St, turn left onto 8th St, turn right at Lower Gold Camp Rd.

From the North: Take exit 141 Cimarron St. off of S I-25, turn left (west) onto Cimarron St, turn left onto 8th St, turn right at Lower Gold Camp Rd.

## Prowers County Fairgrounds- Lamar

Take S I-25 to exit 100A US-50 LaJunta, take US-50 for approximately 120 miles, turn right onto S Main St/US 385, turn right onto Saddle Club Dr./CR FF5, keep right at the fork for Saddle Club Dr, arena is on the right.

## The Ranch- Loveland

Take exit 259 off of N I-25 at Crossroads Blvd, turn right (east) onto Crossroads Blvd, one mile turn left onto Fairgrounds Ave., turn left into entrance.
