Q. What does **"Money Maker"** mean when we see it advertised in red, whether in our newsletter or on a producer's flyer?

A. There are several important factors we'd like to share with you in this answer:

* As a member of SCBRA, when you attend this race and win money, you will be able to DOUBLE YOUR POINTS according to the amount of money you win. If you win \$100, you count it as \$200. Just be sure to INDICATE that the race was a **Money Maker** on your point card and you show the winnings twice or say $\$100 \times 2 = \200 .

* The Producer who sponsors a **"Money Maker"** race promotes SCBRA by drawing in more racers. It is a win-win situation as more racers attend the race while SCBRA members are able to double their points!

* Our SCBRA membership fees DO NOT cover the fabulous awards we give each year. Remember, we give awards to the top 30% of each class which is counted as of July 1. The Board members and the SCBRA members have to work to come up with more money to give out such awesome awards for our members!

Our other fundraiser event for awards is our Silent Auction, TBA for this summer, 2017.

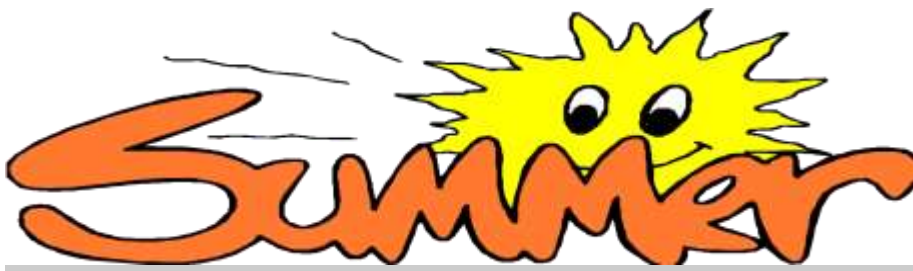

Directions

Adams County Fairgrounds-Brighton

The Adams County Regional Park Complex is located at 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton, Colorado which is one mile west of U.S. 85 on 124th Avenue. (124th Avenue turns into Henderson Road when it crosses the South Platte River.)
From Denver - take I-25 N to I-76. Take I-76 to U.S. Highway 85 N to 124th Avenue. Turn west on 124th Avenue and go one mile to the entrance of the Regional Park Complex.

Arapahoe County Fairgrounds-Aurora

25690 East Quincy Avenue, Aurora, CO 80016, From the North-Follow I-25 S, I-270 E and I-70 E to US-40 W/E Colfax Ave in Adams County. Take exit 288 from I-70 E. Take S Picadilly Rd, E 6th Ave, CO-30 E/S Gun Club Rd and Airline Rd/E Quincy Ave to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County. From the South-Follow I-25 N to Castle Rock. Take exit 184 from I-25 N, Take N Crowfoot Valley Rd, CO-83 N/S Parker Rd and S Aurora Pkwy to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County.

Boulder County Fairgrounds-Longmont

From I-25: Take I-25 to the Longmont or Highway 119 exit West into Longmont. Highway 119 turns into Ken Pratt Blvd. Take Ken Pratt past the railroad tracks. Turn right on Nelson Road right after the tracks. Go almost two blocks directly to the Fairgrounds, which will be on your right.

Crossroads Arena-Penrose

Take I-25 to HWY 50 West out of Pueblo to Penrose. Take exit for CO-115 towards Florence. 13760 Colorado 115, Penrose, CO 81240

Douglas County Fairgrounds-Castle Rock

From the South: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of N I-25, turn right (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd. From the North: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of S I-25, turn left (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd..

El Paso County Fairgrounds- Calhan

Hwy 24 east to Calhan Hwy. Turn south (left) and the fairgrounds are on the right.

Hadley's Arena-Canon City

I-25 South through Colorado Springs to Academy Blvd (the second Academy Blvd) it's SOUTH of the city (pass the World Arena, etc). West on Academy to Hwy 115 turn left on 115 (South) and take it thru the canyon to Hwy 50.
Take Hwy 50 all the way into the heart of Canon City to 9th Street. (Loaf and Jug on one corner, other three corners are banks). At 9th Street take a left (south) go up the hill thru the round about and keep heading south....cemetery on left fairgrounds on right.....rd naturally curves to the left Take that and you'll be going East. Look up and you'll see Cathi's barn. Keep going East to Stop Sign at Pine...turn right onto Pine at Stop Sign and enter the facility at the first set of gates on left.

McKnight's Arena-Pueblo
