Q. As I look at the upcoming races, I see where there are "side pots". Can money earned in a side pot be counted for SCBRA points?

A. Our categories for SCBRA are Open, Senior/50+, Youth and Novice Horse. If a producer has you run in the Open and you roll your time to a "side pot" that is listed as Senior/50+, Youth or Novice Horse, then those earning can be applied for SCBRA points. You would be able to count your money earned for the OPEN as well as any money earned in the side pot category as long as you are a member in those divisions with SCBRA.

Here is an example of what we call a true side pot: Susie Q ran in the Open category and rolled her time for a "side pot" called No Barrel Down. Anyone can sign up for the No Barrel Down <u>BUT</u> since we do not have a category at SCBRA with that title, Susie Q can only count the money she might have won for the Open category. Now if Susie Q was a youth and rolled her time to a side pot with that title, and won money in both the Open and Youth, then she could count both those monies for SCBRA points.

Directions

Adams County Fairgrounds-Brighton

The Adams County Regional Park Complex is located at 9755 Henderson Road, Brighton, Colorado which is one mile west of U.S. 85 on 124th Avenue. (124th Avenue turns into Henderson Road when it crosses the South Platte River.)

From Denver - take I-25 N to I-76. Take I-76 to U.S. Highway 85 N to 124th Avenue. Turn west on 124th Avenue and go one mile to the entrance of the Regional Park Complex.

Arapahoe County Fairgrounds-Aurora

25690 East Quincy Avenue, Aurora, CO 80016, From the North-Follow I-25 S, I-270 E and I-70 E to US-40 W/E Colfax Ave in Adams County. Take exit 288 from I-70 E. Take S Picadilly Rd, E 6th Ave, CO-30 E/S Gun Club Rd and Airline Rd/E Quincy Ave to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County. From the South-Follow I-25 N to Castle Rock. Take exit 184 from I-25 N, Take N Crowfoot Valley Rd, CO-83 N/S Parker Rd and S Aurora Pkwy to Fairgrounds Access Road in Arapahoe County.

Boulder County Fairgrounds-Longmont

Take I-25 to HWY 50 West out of Pueblo to Penrose. Take exit for CO-115 towards Florence. 13760 Colorado 115, Penrose, CO 81240

Douglas County Fairgrounds-Castle Rock

From the South: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of NI-25, turn right (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left

onto Fairgrounds Rd. From the North: Take exit 181 Plum Creek off of S I-25, turn left (east) onto Plum Creek Parkway, turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd..

El Paso County Fairgrounds - Calhan

Hwy 24 east to Calhan Hwy. Turn south (left) and the fairgrounds are on the right.

Hadley's Arena-Canon City
